School Immunization Surveys

- Annual Immunization Survey assesses compliance with school immunization requirements for:
 - Childcare/Preschool
 - Kindergarten
 - Grade 7
 - Grade 11
 - College
- Survey is open from September to January 28, 2022
- Influenza and COVID-19 vaccines are not required for school entry.
 - No surveys accepted after the deadline

Preschool Survey


- All Preschools should have received an email from MDPH Data Assessment unit immassessmentunit@mass.gov
- An email with two links, one for preschool immunization survey and another link for flu survey.
- Also included in the email was your program name, pin number and the grade.
- Preschools Survey can also be accessed through the MIIS.
- Programs with < 30 students should keep a copy of the data they input since a copy will not be emailed back automatically.

Other Grades


- Kindergarten, Grade 7, and Grade 11
- Email from MDPH Data Assessment unit announcing that the survey is now open.
- Survey for these grades are conducted on within MIIS.



⇒ Click SCHOOL, then select Immunization Surveys button from the page display.

Step 2 Start a New Survey ⇒ At the top of the Immunization Surveys page is the grade survey status box. This will display the open/close status of each survey. ⇒ OPEN FOR RESPONSE means you may complete and submit the survey to the MDPH. ⇒ CLOSED means that the survey cannot be accepted by the MDPH at this time. Immunization Surveys ⇒ Click Start a New Survey to begin Grade 7: OPEN FOR RESPONSE Grade 11: OPEN FOR RESPONSE a new survey. ⇒ Survey history below will display surveys that have Survey History been started or completed for the Not Started school district. ⇒ The school survey history display can be sorted by any column or filtered by school year, school name, grade or status.

⇒ Enter the number of students enrolled in the grade for which you are reporting.

⇒ Enter the number of students in the grade who have no immunization records. Keep in mind that

Red Errors

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The number of students for any vaccine must be less than or equal to the total number of students minus the number of students that have no school immunization record.

⇒ At least one of the marked fields must be changed in order to process the survey



Blue messages indicate a possible error based on expected immunization rates. A blue message should trigger a double check for accuracy before advancing to the next page.





- ⇒ Select the Submit Survey button once you are ready to submit the survey.




Survey Response Rates

Kinder decreased by 2% Grade 7 decreased by 6%


Series complete is also the "compliance rate" for students meeting school entry requirements.



Grade 7 Compliance Rates by Antigen 2019-20vs 2020-21




Religious & Medical Exemption Rates among Massachusetts Kindergarten Students, 1986-2020





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
Exemption Rate by Grade 2019-20 vs 2020-21
