MA vision screening protocols and related tools have been revised by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health, effective as of September 1, 2022. For guidance see Updated Massachusetts Vision Screening Protocols, August 2021

Each district is different and there may be specific vendors you must use to purchase new screening tools. With the number of vendors and tools available, identifying the correct tools that meet state requirements can be complicated. The links in this document are designed to assist (not dictate) your inventory review and ordering process. Note: This list provides links to single items. Vendors may supply "combined" vision screening kits that contain, for example, tools grouped by age-group or grade. Ask your vendor representative for the range of Massachusetts screening product kit combinations available to fit your needs.

#### Sample Equipment and Supplies List:

Review your vision screening equipment to determine what tools to eliminate and what tools to purchase.

#### Tools Reminders:

- Visual acuity charts must use **logMAR** notation (e.g., 20/32 vs 20/30). Acceptable near and distance visual acuity charts are **LEA SYMBOLS** and **Sloan Letters** charts. *All other acuity charts are discontinued*.
- The new Massachusetts Sight Line flipbook reflects the new 2022 visual acuity levels, updated from the MassVAT. It includes **LEA SYMBOLS**® and **Sloan Letters** critical line screening cards, preschool through Grade 3.
- Stereoacuity screening will use the "PASS Test-OH (120 Seconds of Arc)". The Random Dot E is discontinued.
- Vision testing machines are discontinued.

#### Additional Screening Accessories:

In addition to the screening tools listed below, the following occluders are recommended. They may be included in some kits, or purchased separately:

- Flip-Up Occluder Glasses with Frosted Lenses for students ages 3 years to 10 years.
- Lorgnette Spectacle Occluder (Mardi Gras Mask) for students ages 10 years and older.
