- Incorporating Multi-Tiered System of Support into School Health Services to Promote Health Equity (90 mins, 1.5 NCPD, Free)
 - This NASN course shows how Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports (PBIS), Response to Intervention (RTI), and Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS) are related, and discusses how the WSCC model and NASN's *Framework*[™] are aligned with the MTSS framework. It describes the differences between the three tiers of MTSS and identifies strategies to use when implementing the three tiers in school health services.
- <u>The MTSS Framework and Comprehensive School Mental Health Systems</u> (90 mins, 1.5 ANCC credits)
 - This SHIELD course describes the core elements of comprehensive school mental health systems and introduces the MTSS Framework. Learners will be guided through questions to help them assess the current supports in their school/district and prompted to identify areas where they can implement some aspects of what they learn in this course.
